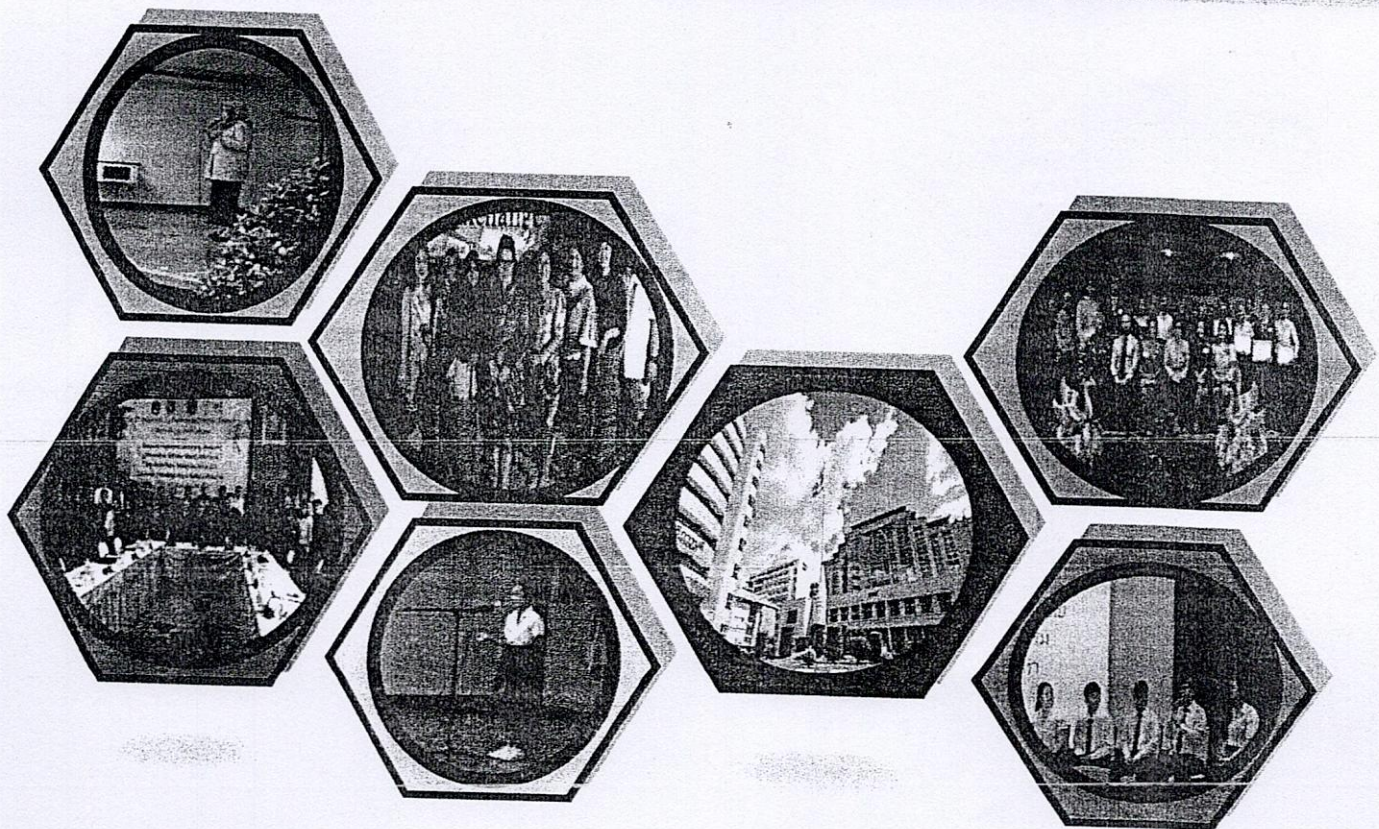


PREFACE

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INTERNATIONAL ENGLISH SPEECH CONTEST FOR RAJABHAT AND ASEAN UNIVERSITIES

I. INTRODUCTION

Over a decade, ASEAN has been increasingly recognized by peoples in Southeast Asian nations as a large number of such public and private organizations have been deliberately preparing their members, with an emphasis on raising their awareness in regard to effects of becoming one of the founding members of the ASEAN Community. Apart from a particular focus on ASEAN knowledge, the English abilities of citizens in each ASEAN country are considered as equally crucial since this language has been used widely as an international means for global communication.

Inasmuch as English is reasonably essential and apparently required as concisely mentioned, not only do ASEAN universities beneficially offer English courses to students, but they also provide them with extracurricular activities, especially exchange events and competitions among educational institutions, to enhance their English proficiency and personal interactions. For this reason, Thepsatri Rajabhat University (TRU), a local public university in Thailand, is organizing an international English speech contest for those ASEAN universities in order to principally promote sustainable relationships, eventually leading to *invaluable exchange of experiences* in terms of ASEAN languages, cultures, and traditions between Thai and other ASEAN students.

II. PURPOSES

1. To provide students from Rajabhat and other ASEAN universities with an opportunity to enhance their English speaking abilities.
2. To promote sustainable relationships among students from Rajabhat and other ASEAN universities.
3. To create an educational network, which is beneficial to both students and lecturers from participating universities in terms of exchange programs and other international competitions in the future.

III. ELIGIBILITY

Contestants whose native language is not English must be Bachelor's degree students, majoring in any fields, from Rajabhat or other ASEAN universities, including Malaysia, Vietnam, Cambodia, Singapore, Brunei, Laos, Myanmar, the Philippines, and Indonesia. No more than three contestants can be sent by one university.

IV. SPEECH SUBJECTS

Contestants must prepare their five - to seven- minute speeches on "**Impacts of Social Media in the 21st Century**".

V. RULES OF CONTEST

1. Each speech will be 5-7 minutes long. A contestant will be disqualified if the speech is less than four minutes or more than eight minutes.
2. Contestants will deliver speeches within 5-7 minutes and be asked questions by the judges.
3. Contestants will deliver their speeches in the order determined by drawing lots, which will be announced on the bulletin board in front of the auditorium.
4. Each contestant must make a speech without any audio-visual aids or equipment and submit extra copies of speech scripts to the judges.
5. Speech contest criteria
 - 5.1 Introduction: Self-introduction, Leading-in, Coherence, Ending (10 points)
 - 5.2 Content: Relatedness to the theme, Language Usage, Comprehensibility, Sequence, Conclusion (40 points)
 - 5.3 Voice Usage: Pronunciation, Accent, Cluster, Final Sound (20 points)
 - 5.4 Appearance: Body Language, Eye Contact, Personality (20 points)
 - 5.5 Time Management: Appropriateness (5 points)
 - 5.6 Ability to Answer Questions (5 points)

VI. AWARDS

1. The winner and his/her speech coach will be awarded 9,900 Baht (approx. 330 USD) with a certificate.
2. The first runner-up and his/her speech coach will be awarded 8,000 Baht (approx. 265 USD) with a certificate.
3. The second runner-up and his/her speech coach will be awarded 7,000 Baht (approx. 235 USD) with a certificate.
4. The third runner-up and his/her speech coach will be awarded 6,000 Baht (approx. 200 USD) with a certificate.
5. The fourth runner-up and his/her speech coach will be awarded 5,000 Baht (approx. 165 USD) with a certificate.

* Awards will be paid in Thai baht.

*** All contestants will receive a participation certificate, which will be available for collection on the contest day from 01:00 p.m. to 04:00 p.m.*

3. Text Preparation

3.1. Paper format must be an A4 sheet with top and left margins of 1.5 inch,
bottom and right of 1 inch.

3.2. Name of the title must be only 14 pt bold, aligned at the center of the content
page. Line and paragraph spacing is single space.

3.3. Name(s) of the author and advisor (if any), 12 pt bold, must be typed next to
an English title with single space and must be aligned at the right margin.

3.4. Footnote consists of an academic title, job position, faculty, major,
institution/work place. The footnote font must be 10 pt and placed on the first page.

3.5. English abstract font should be 12 pt bold, aligned at the center of the content
page. The abstract must be written as "ABSTRACT". The text of the abstract is 12 pt.

3.6. Headings of the research components must be 12 pt bold, aligned at the left
margin. The text of the paper should be 12 pt.

3.7. Indentation must be started at 0.5 inch.

3.8. Tables must be prepared in a consistent form and should be numbered
consecutively from 1 until the end of the paper. The order of the tables and captions should
be at the same line, typed at the top of the table and aligned with the left margin.

3.9. Figure must be prepared in a consistent form and should be numbered
consecutively from 1 until the end of the paper. Place a figure's order and caption in the same
line.

3.10. In-text citation must be strictly followed the APA in-text citation style as
(Author, Year, Page).

3.11. References must be APA references style and listed in an alphabetical order.

4. Oral presentation

4.1. The presenters must prepare a PowerPoint or any other presentation forms
available and send the latest files to the conference moderator in advance for at least 1 hour
prior to their speech sessions. The presentation rooms are all equipped with computers and

projectors. Should the presenters use other devices, they must initially inform the staff when the paper acceptance is notified.

4.2. The presenters must present their works by themselves and answer the questions provided by the experts. The certificates will be provided after the completion of their oral presentations.

4.3. The languages available in the oral presentation are Thai and English. The presenters will be allocated 10 minutes for their presentations and 10 minutes for questions and answers.

5. Poster Preparation

The conference organizer will print out an 80 x 120 cm poster for all the presenters. The poster will be allocated at the given poster presentation area before the conference begins (additional charge is 500 baht). The text given to the organizer must be an A4 format, 18 pt, and it does not exceed 1 paper page. The poster presenters must strictly prepare their texts according to the following headings:

- 5.1. Research Title
- 5.2. Author
- 5.3. Abstract in English language
- 5.4. Introduction
- 5.5. Purposes of the Study
- 5.6. Research Methodology
- 5.7. Research Results
- 5.8. Significance of the Study

Note: The headings can be subject to change. If there are any captions, charts, and diagrams embedded, the presenters need to prepare the high-quality .jpg files separately from the text. Also, the presenters must send their self-picture dressed up in the appropriate manner in high-quality .jpg files.

6. Poster Presentation

The poster presenters should be stationed at their posters at the provided areas and scheduled time in order to present and answer the questions from the experts and audiences. The certificates will be provided after finishing the session.

Note: If the presenters do not appear at the scheduled time. A notification will be sent to their institutions or workplaces, and the certificates will be retrieved.

Paper Submission

The presenters must submit the papers in the format of .doc and .pdf via the online conference system at <http://m-journal.tru.ac.th/journal/conference2019>. The paper submitted to the conference must be the original manuscript which is not previously published in other conferences or journals. The paper format must be strictly followed the guideline of the conference, and the presenters must carefully check the correctness in terms of grammar and spelling of their papers.
