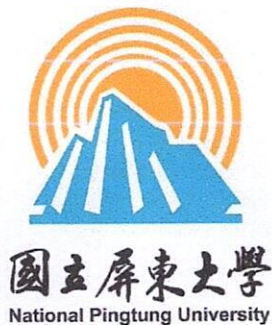

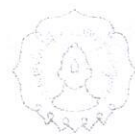
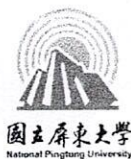

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## THE 8<sup>th</sup> INTERNATIONAL ENGLISH SPEECH CONTEST FOR RAJABHAT AND ASEAN UNIVERSITIES

Thepsatri Rajabhat University, Thailand  
5<sup>th</sup> September 2022

### I. INTRODUCTION

Over a decade, ASEAN has been increasingly recognized by peoples in Southeast Asian nations as a large number of such public and private organizations have been deliberately preparing their members, with an emphasis on raising their awareness in regard to effects of becoming one of the founding members of the ASEAN Community. Apart from a particular focus on ASEAN knowledge, the English abilities of citizens in each ASEAN country are considered as equally crucial since this language has been used widely as an international means for global communication.

In as much as English is reasonably essential and apparently required as concisely mentioned, not only do ASEAN universities beneficially offer English courses to students, but they also provide them with extracurricular activities, especially exchange events and competitions among educational institutions, to enhance their English proficiency and personal interactions. For this reason, Thepsatri Rajabhat University (TRU), a local public university in Thailand, is organizing an international English speech contest for those ASEAN universities in order to principally promote sustainable relationships, eventually leading to invaluable exchange of experiences in terms of ASEAN languages, cultures, and traditions between Thai and other ASEAN students.

### II. PURPOSES

1. To provide students from Rajabhat and other ASEAN universities with an opportunity to enhance their English speaking abilities.
2. To promote sustainable relationships among students from Rajabhat and other ASEAN universities.
3. To create an educational network, which is beneficial to both students and lecturers from participating universities in terms of exchange programs and other international competitions in the future.



### III. ELIGIBILITY

Contestants whose native language is not English must be Bachelor's degree students, majoring in any fields, from Rajabhat or other ASEAN universities, including Malaysia, Vietnam, Cambodia, Singapore, Brunei, Laos, Myanmar, the Philippines, and Indonesia. No more than three contestants can be sent by one university.

### IV. SPEECH SUBJECT

Contestants must prepare their five - to seven- minute speeches on  
**"Body Shaming"**

### V. RULES OF CONTEST

1. Each speech will be 5-7 minutes long. A contestant will be disqualified if the speech is less than four minutes or more than eight minutes.
2. Contestants will deliver speeches within 5-7 minutes.
3. Contestants will deliver their speeches in the order determined by drawing lots, which will be announced on the bulletin board in front of the auditorium.
4. Each contestant must make a speech without any audio-visual aids or equipment.
5. Speech contest criteria
  - 5.1 Introduction: Self-introduction, Leading-in, Coherence, Ending (10 points)
  - 5.2 Content: Relatedness to the theme, Language Usage, Comprehensibility, Sequence, Conclusion (40 points)
  - 5.3 Voice Usage: Pronunciation, Accent, Cluster, Final Sound (25 points)
  - 5.4 Appearance: Body Language, Eye Contact, Personality (20 points)
  - 5.5 Time Management: Appropriateness (5 points)
6. The five contestants who can pass to the final round will only be asked a question and have to spend at least 1.30 minutes to answer it. (Ability to Answer Question: 20 points)

### VI. AWARDS

1. The winner and his/her speech coach will be awarded 9,900 Baht (approx. 280 USD) with a certificate.
2. The first runner-up and his/her speech coach will be awarded 8,000 Baht (approx. 225 USD) with a certificate.
3. The second runner-up and his/her speech coach will be awarded 7,000 Baht (approx. 195 USD) with a certificate.
4. The third runner-up and his/her speech coach will be awarded 6,000 Baht (approx. 170 USD) with a certificate.
5. The fourth runner-up and his/her speech coach will be awarded 5,000 Baht (approx. 140 USD) with a certificate.



\* Awards will be paid in Thai baht.

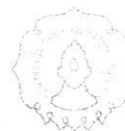
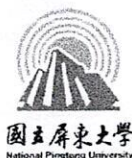

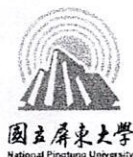

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## THE 1<sup>st</sup> NEWSCASTING COMPETITION

Thepsatri Rajabhat University, Thailand

5<sup>th</sup> September 2022

### Introduction

The 5<sup>th</sup> International Academic & Cultural Exchange 2022 is organizing Newscasting Competition on 5<sup>th</sup> September 2022 for all students at university level in Thailand and overseas to deliver news as a professional news anchor in television within the given time based on the round. In this competition, the participants are to display their competence in presenting various types of news items which require competence in language, rhetoric and the use of paralinguistic communication such as voice modulation, poise and gestures. The contest has two rounds, Preliminary Round and Final Round, with different content of news reading based on the themes of *"The Air Pollution from Forest Fires"* and *"Global Climate Change"*. Each contestant will be provided a maximum of 5 minutes duration to deliver their newscasting for each round including opening and closing sentence and considered by professional native English judges based on criteria of Voice/Volume, Facial Expression, Manner and Elocution.

### PURPOSES

The objectives of competition are to give a chance for all varsity students to compete and improve their English ability and skill, and provide an opportunity for all participants to do deep understanding and research about the subject for the theme given.

### ELIGIBILITY

Each university from Rajabhat or other ASEAN universities, is allowed to send only one delegate whose non-native English speaker majoring in any fields.

### COMPETITION SEQUENCES

Newscasting Competition is divided into two rounds which are:

1. Preliminary Round (five participants with the highest score will go to the final round.)
2. Final Round (the winner of this competition will be determined based on the results of this round.)

### RULES OF COMPETITION

1. Contestants should be registered before the competition starts at least 15 minutes.
2. Each newscasting in both rounds will be within 5 minutes long.
3. Contestants will deliver their newscasting in the order determined by drawing lots, which will be announced on the bulletin in front of the auditorium.



4. Before the preliminary round of competition, all contestants will be provided 3 minutes of preparation to review the first news in the theme of “The Air Pollution from Forest Fires” and five highest scored contestants are able to go to the final round.

5. Before the final round, those contestants are allowed to review the second news in the theme of “Global Climate Change” for three minutes before starting the final competition.

6. Using dictionaries or electronic devices is prohibited.

7. Criteria of Newscasting Competition

7.1 Voice/Volume: Fluency Sounds, Intonation, Articulation, Tempo (35 points)

7.2 Facial Expression: Eye contact, Interaction with Audiences (15 points)

7.3 Manner: Personality, Self-presentation, Confidence (25 points)

7.4. Elocution: Accuracy Correctness, Pronunciation, Fluency (25 points)

## AWARDS

1. The winner and his/her speech coach will be awarded 9,900 Baht (approx. 280 USD) with a certificate.
2. The first runner-up and his/her speech coach will be awarded 8,000 Baht (approx. 225 USD) with a certificate.
3. The second runner-up and his/her speech coach will be awarded 7,000 Baht (approx. 195 USD) with a certificate.
4. The third runner-up and his/her speech coach will be awarded 6,000 Baht (approx. 170 USD) with a certificate.
5. The fourth runner-up and his/her speech coach will be awarded 5,000 Baht (approx. 140 USD) with a certificate.

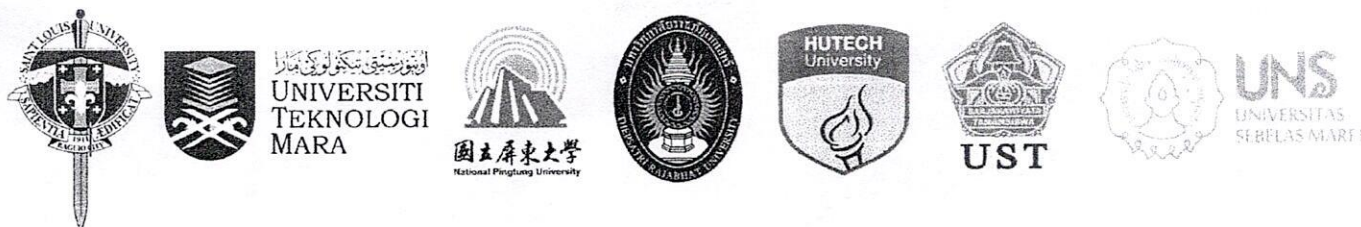

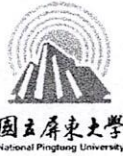

## 2. Text Preparation

2.1. Paper format must be an A4 sheet with top and left margins of 1.5-inch, bottom and right of 1 inch.

2.2. Name of the title must be only 14 pt bold, aligned at the center of the content page. Line and paragraph spacing is single space.

2.3. Name(s) of the author and advisor (if any), 12 pt bold, must be typed next to an English title with single space and must be aligned at the right margin.

2.4. Footnote consists of an academic title, job position, faculty, major, institution/work place. The footnote font must be 10 pt and placed on the first page.

2.5. English abstract font should be 12 pt bold, aligned at the center of the content page. The abstract must be written as "ABSTRACT". The text of the abstract is 12 pt.

2.6. Headings of the research components must be 12 pt bold, aligned at the left margin. The text of the paper should be 12 pt.

2.7. Indentation must be started at 0.5 inch.

2.8. Tables must be prepared in a consistent form and should be numbered consecutively from 1 until the end of the paper. The order of the tables and captions should be at the same line, typed at the top of the table and aligned with the left margin.

2.9. Figure must be prepared in a consistent form and should be numbered consecutively from 1 until the end of the paper. Place a figure's order and caption in the same line.

2.10. In-text citation must be strictly followed the APA (7<sup>th</sup> edition) in-text citation style.

2.11. References must be APA (7<sup>th</sup> edition) references style and listed in an alphabetical order.
